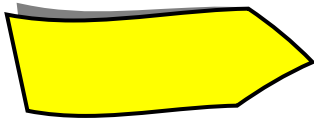

HOUSEKEEPING

HOT TUB

Hot tub is open from 10 AM until 10 PM daily. Children must be accompanied by an adult. It is recommended that you limit hot tub exposure to 15 minutes at a time. Pregnant women and those with health risks such as high blood pressure should consult their physician prior to use. There are no lifeguards at these facilities. Use them at your own risk. Please note: facilities are periodically closed for maintenance and cleaning.

VALUABLES

The owners assume no responsibility for valuables and other personal items left in your accommodations. Please keep your door locked to prevent theft and do not leave valuables out in plain view. Please take your keys with you when you leave the unit.

PARKING HINTS

Please park your car in the designated areas. There is an underground parking garage available for one car. There is a garage door opener in the wooden bin on the kitchen bar.

Once you have found the correct place for your vehicle, we encourage you to enjoy the ease of moving from place to place by taking advantage of Telluride's free transportation system. The Galloping Goose bus runs by the condo, and through town approximately every 15 minutes. Telluride also offers the only commuter gondola in the country, the "G", connecting the towns of Telluride and Mountain Village. Hours of operation for the gondola are 7 AM through 11 PM. The gondola is closed during the off season. The gondola may also close at any time due to high winds and electrical storms.

Parking is available along the streets. Always read the winter parking regulation signs carefully. All streets have specific times when no parking is allowed due to snow removal needs. Snow removal in the Town of Telluride is done daily on different days of the week, different time of the day and even different sides of the street.

Don't park in the center of Main Street (Colorado Ave.) even for a moment. It is illegal and you could be ticketed or towed.

THE RIVER TRAIL

When you are crossing the main bridge out of Cimmaron Lodge, take a quick right as soon as you cross the river. You will now be on the San Miguel River, walking on the River Trail. You can walk the length of town, passed the gondola, and up into Bear Creak by following this path.

UTILITIES

Our condominium is separately metered and has its own heating controls and hot water heater. This means that hot water is limited just as it is in your own home. Please help conserve energy by turning down the thermostats and turning off most of the lights when you go out.

PHONE SERVICE

Our unit is equipped with toll restricted phones which operate on private phone lines. Your number is 970-728-4214. If someone is trying to reach you, they can dial that number directly. Long distance calls may be placed by using a toll free access calling card. Telluride has just 2 phone number prefixes 728 & 369, both in area code 970.

EQUIPMENT RENTAL

Rental equipment is available in the Cimmaron Lodge complex. A wide selection of rental gear is available at Telluride Sports. Telluride sports is open from 8 AM—6 PM daily, they can be reached at 728-4228.

LIFT TICKETS

Lift tickets and lesson packages are available at the Lift 7 base area. There is a ticket office just to the right of Lift 7.

COMPUTER/DSL SERVICE

A laptop computer is provided for your use. Computer is fully connected, but may be turned off upon arrival. Please lift screen with release on front of computer and press power button in the upper left corner of the keyboard area. When the computer starts up double-click on the selection "GUEST" to continue. Once the computer is fully booted up connection to internet will be made automatically. TELLURIDE AIRPORT

If you flew directly into Telluride's airport, please be aware that your departing flight could be diverted due to weather conditions. On the day of your departure you must call the local airline's office at least 3 hours before your scheduled departure time. Even if the weather appears clear, your flight may depart from Montrose, a 65-mile 1 ½ hour drive. You should be prepared for the necessary extra travel time involved in getting to Montrose should your plane be diverted. Check with your airline for further details.

It is advisable to make advance reservations for your taxi ride to the airport.

You are visiting a beautiful area and we hope you enjoy every minute of your stay. Some of the very features which make these high valleys so attractive can cause problems unless you know how to prevent them. Following are some suggestions.

ALTITUDE

Here, some 9,000 feet high, the air is thinner and there is less oxygen available. You may already have noticed that you are breathing deeper or faster and feel a bit short of breath at times. This is one of the body's first reactions to the altitude. Your heart probably beats faster. These are normal helpful responses. You may have a headache, a touch of nausea, or feel tired. About 15% of all vacationers experience such symptoms, which usually disappear 24-36 hours after arrival. If these symptoms should grow worse or if you are worried, please get help. Doctors here are familiar with altitude illness and may ease your discomfort during the adjustment period.

Alcohol has extra impact at altitude-one drink does the work of two-so monitor your alcohol intake while you are acclimating.

SUN AND TEMPERATURE

The sun has more power in this thin air and a bad sunburn can spoil your stay; use a protective sun screen. It gets very chilly at night, so take extra warm clothes if you might be caught outside after dusk. In winter most people wear enough warm clothes, but be sure your boots and gloves aren't wet or too tight.

HUMIDITY

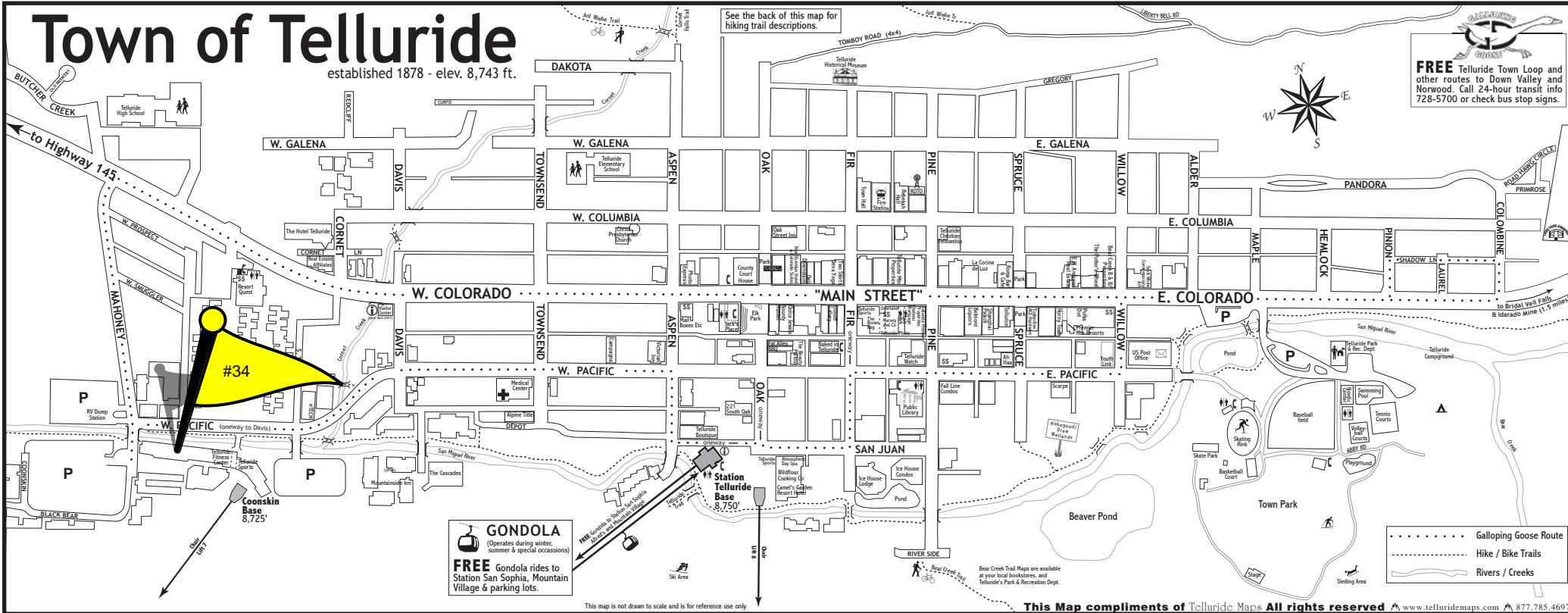
The crisp, dry mountain air is exhilarating, but you'll lose more body moisture from the deeper breathing and from perspiring (often you won't even notice this). It's important to maintain your body's water store, so drink two or three times more water or juices than usual. The dryness also affects contact lens wearers who may need to moisturize their eyes more frequently. Contact lenses may need to be removed on a daily basis to let the eye take in more oxygen.

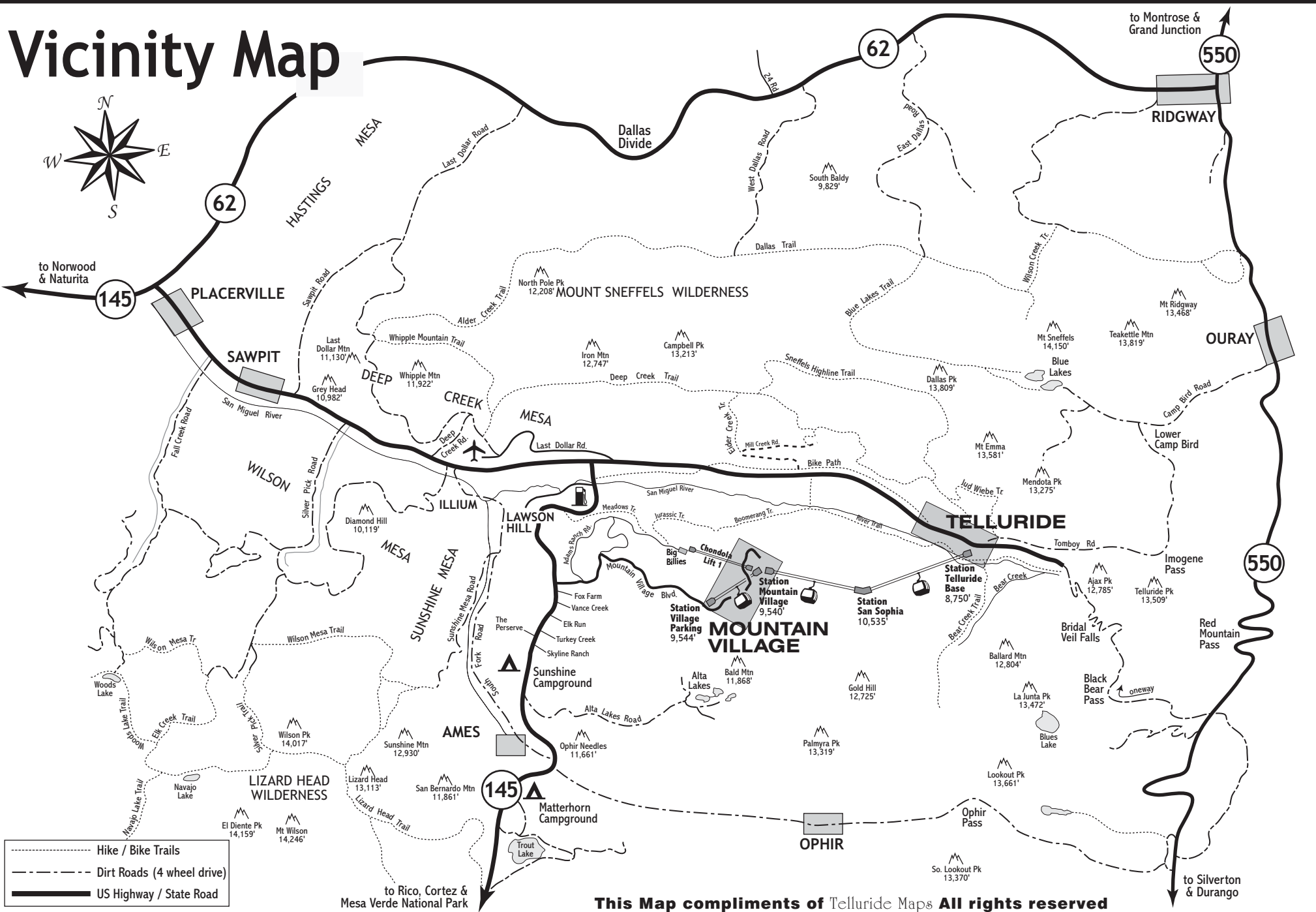
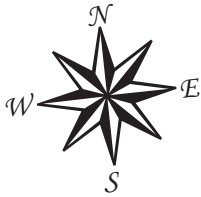


GONDOLA

Directions to Cimarron Lodge:

Cimarron Lodge is located at 300 S. Mahoney.

Mahoney is the first street on the right as you pull into Telluride.

Cimarron Lodge is at the base of Lift 7.

You will be staying in **Unit #34**.

One key is for the front door the other is for the hot-tub area.

FROM Montrose Regional Airport

1. Start out going Southeast on AIRPORT RD. 0.1 miles
2. Turn RIGHT to stay on AIRPORT RD. <.1 miles
3. Turn LEFT onto US-50/N TOWNSEND AVE. 2.6 miles
continue to follow N TOWNSEND AVE
4. N TOWNSEND AVE becomes US-550 24.6 miles
5. Turn RIGHT onto MAIN ST/CO-62. Continue 23.3 miles
to follow CO-62.
6. Turn LEFT onto CO-145. 12.7 miles
7. Stay straight to go onto CO-145 SPUR. 2.8 miles
8. Turn RIGHT onto MAHONEY DR. 0.2 miles
9. End at 300 MAHONEY DR TELLURIDE CO
